- 3. We should be getting a new police officer in the Uists.
- 4. We need to put out a questionnaire to ask Berneray residents if they would like the overhead power lines buried, and the see if this is possible.
- 5. The work on the renovations of the Harbour toilets is due to start soon. We have received a grant from the Challenge fund for some of the cost of the the work.
- 6. Malcolm McPhaille and his superiors from Scottish Water are due to come to Berneray this week to carry out a taste test on the water at the ends of the pipes to see how bad it is. We are hopeful this will help our case to get the old pipes replaced.
