Matters Arising:

Lighthouse keeper's memorial – planning approval for the memorial has been received from the Comhairle; awaiting confirmation later this month of the various funding bids to the Bealach Project, Sgioba na Gaidhlig, Celebrate Scotland, Club Gniomhachas nan Gaidheal and the Northern Lighthouse Board.

Crofting Issues – things are moving on, calls for the Crofting Act 2010 to be re-done; constant pressure on the Crofting Commission with the Chief Executive leaving, and no resolution to the grazing committees' problems.
