Matters Arising	2.1	<b>Community bus</b> – Mr. Angus Smith pursuing various avenues for funding, project ongoing.
	2.2	<b>Floodlights</b> – Cllr Morrison advised the floodlights for both the war memorial and school playground have been ordered.
	2.3	<b>Defibrillators</b> – Breascleite school is to be the first school to be trained in ELS, the current community defibrillator will remain in situ which will release another defibrillator for a site in Garynahine, yet to be agreed.
