- 1. Minutes read and approved.

- 3. It was agreed that we should ask Andrew Ross what the costs of the Berneray Website were, and offer to pay them.
- 4. The fire service at Lochmaddy has recruitment problems, with 6 unfilled vacancies.
- 5. Cassandra is studying engineering at Glasgow University, and is going to Rwanda to encourage the take up of Engineering by local girls. We have been asked if we could help with the costs associated with her trip.
