Defibrillators

Achmore defibrillator road sign is in place, but the machine is still to be installed on the side of the meeting house. There is a defibrillator also available for Garynahine, so training can be joint for Achmore and Garynahine
Grimshader defibrillator had red light showing when Angus Morrison was campaigning – the battery appeared to be dead, so a new battery has been put in and now all well. We were reminded of the importance of regularly checking that the light is green, every week.

We await the outcome of the capital programme plans to see if there is funding available for extending the surgery car park
