Matters Arising	2.1 Community bus – The Community bus scheme is not currently open, enquiries to be made to Point & Sandwick Trust, Horshader, and Tesco bags of help. 2.2 Defibrillators – two sites have proved to be unsuitable. Other sites are to be highlighted, including at Garynahine Lodge. 2.3 Crofting Issues – The close results could suggest that two representatives are needed. The Council wished the new representative good luck. Concerns still remain regarding LFA/ANC. 2.4 Cnoc Mor – No new response from Keith Bray. Only one resident remains. Continue to follow up with HHP. 2.5 Lochganvich road – ongoing 2.6 Rural Locality Planning Group – Mrs Morrison hoped to encourage further attendance at these meetings as they have a significant say at the IJB, especially regarding the provision of extra care housing in rural Lewis. 2.7 Pot holes, ditches and rhododendrons Pot holes have been filled on the main roads; ditches are on an ongoing rota; rhododendrons depend on the point of origin.
