Matters Arising	2.1 Community bus – Application forms received from Horshader Trust, and enquiries Point & Sandwick Trust ongoing. Any applications made to Horshader or Point to be appraised by community council prior to submission, and source local need. 2.2 Defibrillators – Cllr. Morrison to investigate further the most suitable site in Garynahine. 2.3 Crofting Issues – Kenny MacLennan met with the Crofting Law Group from Scottish Government, matters on going. 2.4 Cnoc Mor – letter from Dena MacLeod, Chief Executive HHP stating the current position, with one tenant still to be re-housed. Kenny MacLennan stated that the community, together with Carloway Estate Trust, are keen to look at the possibility of buying the property once it becomes available. HHP are to be asked to confirm that an offer will be considered, and whether there is any leeway within their procedures for the community to have first option before the property goes on the open market. 2.5 Lochganvich road – ongoing 2.6 Pot holes, ditches and rhododendrons – request to be sent to Technical Services for an Engineer to carry out a site visit of the area to highlight the various problems with road edges falling away and the ditches on the Breasclete loop road that are especially bad.
