Alice introduced herself as the recently appointed Community Learning and Development Worker for the area.  Anne Kelvin and Nicky McCrimmon are in the process of carrying out inspections of communities across Lewis and Harris, with regard to education and development, and discussed with members their roles and the functioning of Uig Community Council. Following their inspection, Anne and Nicky left the meeting.		
		Richard Gollin, owner of Baile na Cille Guest House, Timsgarry, addressed the meeting regarding complaints he has received from guests and visitors about the state of the Baile na Cille graveyard, which is adjacent his property. He stated that fencing is damaged and bones have been seen on the surface of the ground, and is therefore asking for the fencing to be reinstated. He has been trying to ascertain who has responsibility for maintenance of the graveyard and, so far, he is under the impression that it is classed as a National Monument, owned by Uig and Hamnaway Estate, and maintained by Uig Community Council. Mr. Gollin suggested that he and the owners of Uig Lodge would be willing to pay towards repair of the fencing.
