<b>2. Minutes of Meeting of 17<sup>th</sup> September 2018</b>	The Minutes were approved by Alex Macdonald and seconded by Murdo MacIver
<b>3. Matters arising</b>	Any matters arising were included in the Agenda.
<b>4. Donald Martin Duties of the Lord Lieutenant</b>	<p>Donald Martin replaced Alexander Matheson as the Lord Lieutenant for the Western Isles. There are 35 in Scotland to cover all the Local Authority Areas.</p> <p>In the Western Isles the Lord Lieutenant has 7 Deputes and Margaret MacKay from Anderson MacArthur is the Clerk to the Lieutenancy.</p> <p>There is a WEB site that will provide information on the work and role of the Lord Lieutenant.</p> <p>1/ Royal Visits. The Lord Lieutenant can apply for a Royal Visit and can assist with guests and the program.</p> <p>2/ Honours. The public have to register their nominations on line and the process can take 18 months.</p> <p>3/ Queens Garden Party. Those who are involved in Community work can be eligible to be invited.</p> <p>4/ 100year Birthday Cards. Relatives have to apply on line and the Lord Lieutenant will be happy to present the card, if invited.</p> <p>60<sup>th</sup> Wedding Anniversary cards. Relatives have to apply on line.</p> <p>The Lord Lieutenant can advise on the Queens Award for Volunteer Services, the Duke of Edinburgh Awards and is also involved with the Cadets.</p>

<b>5. Garenin Roadside Pathway</b>	The Chairman has been in contact with Murdo MacKay in the Council over potential funding opportunities however none were appropriate. The Chairman and Alex MacDonald have been in contact with Sally Reynolds from the Estate Office and Jane MacIntosh from HIE. HIE have agreed to fund the Feasibility Study into a pathway from the junction near the Bridge to the Black Houses in Garenin
<b>6. Defib Units (Maintenance)</b>	It was agreed to pay for the replacement pads for the units at the old school annex and at 15 Tolsta Chaolais
