Angus Morrison advised that the reduced speed limit is in the process of being extended to include this scheme but it was agreed that ensuring children's safety was the parent's responsibility.
- Joanne Mitchell advised that the playpark grant money has still not been paid as we are awaiting copies of the latest bank statement to send to CnES. JM to seek clarification from CnES over responsibility for play park maintenance before accepting grant.
- Alex MacKintosh asked Angus Morrison to look into why windows are covered under the Tighean Innse Gall maintenance scheme but not the double glazing.
- Sarah MacDonald and Annabel MacKay advised that they are having a meeting next week to discuss holding a NLCA community forum meeting for all local residents in the near future.
