3 Carloway Care Units	Emma MacSween from CNES outlined the issues that affect the Care Units. Currently the Carloway Unit is empty and although there were two residents in the Garrabost Unit, one has since left.
	There is a review of the service being undertaken by Ron Culley and this will be presented to The Integrated Joint Board. Changes to this service have been instigated to meet the requirements of the Care Commission. Those requiring the service require to have a Tenancy Agreement for the accommodation as well as a Service Agreement for their care. Another barrier to potential users of the service is they may have to sell their home as a Care Unit as classed the same as a Care Home. Those who currently leave hospital require doubling up of care and this is too expensive to provide in a Care Unit. A Care Unit will need a minimum of sixteen beds to be viable. Iain MacKinnon CNES is currently looking at the options for the Rural Lewis Care Home. Extra care sheltered housing will be part of these proposals.
	There was a discussion about holding public meeting as both Community Council members and Cllr Fraser have been approached by people concerned about the Care Units. Emma would be happy to attend such a meeting.

5. Garenin Roadside Pathway	Peter Coldwell to make an application to SUSTRANS to pay for the feasibility study. He has asked for more letters of agreement to support the application. Sustrans may pay 50% of the capital costs of the project and the Community Council will have to fundraise for the balance.
