3. Purpose of meeting	To discuss progress of Garenin Roadside Pathway. Neil Ingram and Peter Coldwell were welcomed to the meeting.

<p>4. Discussion</p>	<p>There had been some confusion about the road and it had been thought that the pathway would be put in to the car park, however, this was not the case. This would need to go back to Sustrans. Peter Coldwell requested photographs. Community responses had been sent to Peter Coldwell by Angaidh Macleod, however, these had not been received. It would be worth waiting for Sustrans as they would pay half the cost. The Community Council would then have to find match funding. This would be easier if some funds were already in place.</p> <p>Additional information to be sent to Peter who will send the completed form to be edited. There is anecdotal evidence that the numbers of cyclists is increasing. The application is to be submitted as soon as it is completed. Sustrans would pay for a consultant to come out, plans would be submitted to the community and then the plans would go to Sustrans.</p> <p>A width of approximately 2.5 m would be made for cyclists and pedestrians although this would be discussed with the consultant. Sustrans would be likely to want a defined kerb as otherwise would be regarded as road widening. It may be difficult to get the additional width given the ditches at either side of the road.</p> <p>Peter will include cruise ships and take note of tour buses. The completed form will be sent to Angaidh by Peter before the next meeting.</p> <p>Sustrans route 780 is the A858 so going to Garenin would be a relevant extension.</p> <p>Peter will bring core path materials to the next meeting.</p>
