## Crown Estate Funding

This meeting was called following a meeting between Bernera and Uig community councils on 16th March, and attended by Catriona Maclean on behalf of Uig Community Council.

It was agreed that the two community councils would work together for the purpose of the Crown Estate Funding process, and will be the vehicle by which funding will be delivered from CnES for successful projects.

The ward allocation of Crown Estate Funding will be divided between the three areas - Carloway to Lochganvich, Lochs, and Uig and Bernera. The funds for Uig and Bernera will be split 50/50 for each area.

The criteria for applications are as follows:

- Directly or indirectly create jobs or sustain existing jobs.
- Contribute to population retention.
- Fit with local plans and priorities.
- Successfully deliver intended outcomes.
- Be sustainable on withdrawal of funding.
- Represent good value for money.

Funding up to 100% may be allocated though opportunities to draw down additional funding should be explored.

Applications should be received by close of business on the 31st March and should be submitted to Alice Murray. These will then all be recorded on a spread sheet, reviewed by Council project officers and then sent to the three Ward Councillors - Ranald Fraser, Angus Morrison and Norman Macdonald - for the final decision on applications.
