6	Chessmen	<p>Mary Ann Maciver has contacted CMacL regarding the deteriorating condition of the Chessmen at Ardroy and the Hall. R. Maclean will apply oil to the Chessmen in spring, when the weather improves.</p> <p>It was suggested that the Chessman at Ardroy should be mounted on a plinth and the rabbit holes filled in. NAMacD doubted that a plinth would help, as the Chessman at the hall is standing on concrete and is still absorbing water and deteriorating; and that it is not feasible to fill in all the rabbit holes.</p> <p>Agreed to look into creating a concrete base at Ardroy during next Spring/Summer.</p>	CMacL NAMacD	
7	Crown Estate Fund Applications	<p>CMacL has received from Alice Murray a list of applications submitted. NAMacD gave an update. The closing date for applications was Monday last week (30th November). The total amount of all the applications is £425k. Uig and Bernera are likely to receive £25k each. The Council (CnES) will be looking to prioritise organisations who will acquire match-funding for their projects. Projects will start being funded from next April.</p>		
8	AOCB	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Angus Morrison confirmed that the new defibrillator has been installed on the outside of the garage at The Cottage, Mangersta Road End. The defib. app has been updated to show its location. He noted that this is the only defibrillator in Uig to have a key code to open the wall unit. CMacL has put a note of the code on the outside of the unit. <p>More training will be arranged when the C19 restrictions permit, but in the meantime Angus advised that if it is necessary to carry out CPR on a person, their nose and mouth should be covered with a light cloth or handkerchief before starting chest compressions, and Mouth to Mouth should NOT be given.</p> <p>The new equipment was funded by an anonymous donor. LD to write to John Gillies at Ken Macdonald Solicitors to acknowledge and confirm that the defibrillator is installed and working.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> GA asked what is being planned for the Tea Room at the Hall next year. NAMacD said that enders are being sought for running the Tea Room next year. A copy of the notice has been shared on the Uig Community Council FaceBook page. 	LD
