1	Minutes of Previous Meeting Proposed: DM Seconded: DFM		
2	Matters Arising Eilean Glas Lighthouse – application under crown estates was withdrawn by NHT DFM to follow up on reasons why Bridge Lights – PF to action Scalpay school Sale – GF to chase up		
3	Harris Forum KM and GF gave an update. DM to be the second Scalpay CC rep on the Forum. KM explained the application from the Golf Club to become members of the Harris Forum. Following a discussion, it was agreed that a Sports Harris Rep be the recommendation and it was also stated that the Golf Club profile was not in line with Forum membership.		
4	Scalpay Community Assoc MM gave an update on the proposal and the funding application from them. Following a discussion, it was proposed that they be given £2000. DM to get details of the proposal and what the feasibility study is for. If all happy with this then the money can be given.		
5	Councillor Updates JM gave an update on the Exec heads situation and advised that Director of Finance would be leaving on 24 th Feb. They were trying to progress issues regarding gritting. Budget heavily overspent. MM asked how the gritters were deployed as often the weather in Harris was different from Lewis. GF said that both SCC and NHCC asked for grit bins but that SHCC felt they wouldn't be any good. Looking at whether ward funding could be used to buy some. Cost around £100 each plus £80 to fill and maintain each one. Housing also being looked at with an accommodation block project being considered for Tarbert and also 10 2-3 bed houses for Leverburgh. PF said that gritting has been the main issue he has had to deal with.		
6	Police Update He has been in post for 1.5 years but has only recently moved to Tarbert. Gives him more opportunity to be in the area. Main issues at present include phone scams mainly involving calls from a supposed "bank fraud team". Some had lost up to £10K		
4	AOCB MM advised that the new chief officer of the ICJB was now in post. She encouraged everyone eligible to attend the Covid vaccine clinic in Tarbert later this week. MM to forward email to DM and KM to complete for additional signators.
