2	Approval of Minutes Minutes of meeting held on 1st May 2023, agreed - proposed JS, seconded WG. Matters Arising: <ul style="list-style-type: none">GA and LD attended a presentation by the Army Engagement Team at An Lanntair on 15th May. GA gave a summary of the event. The presentation included an overview of the scope and depth of defence in Scotland; speakers of various ranks gave personal accounts of their own experience in the army and reasons for joining; current facts and figures and a look ahead at how the defence forces will look in the years ahead. A very interesting Q&A session followed, with a number of the audience giving testimony to their own, positive, association with the army.
