5. FINANCE

6. COUNCILLORS REPORT

PST – Point and Sandwick Trust. Third base complete and cables being laid by SSE. Initial works complete by end of the year and the turbines being installed in February.

Stornoway Regeneration – Scottish Government – Glasgow Conference. Repeat in January. Rachel McCormack presentation on Arnish and Newton developments.

Castle Grounds Project – Meeting postponed – officers not available. Meetings with HLF and Historic Scotland. More to report in the New Year.

Road Markings – Still waiting to be completed. Mossend Junction still to be marked. Steinish still to be done.

Speeding – East Street – made worse by cars parking on the Main Road. Mossend at Steinish Junction is also a problem. Reported to Chief Inspector Gordon MacLeod.

Hebridean Men's Cancer Support Group – Documentary with Mac TV. 105 men ran in the 5K race on 22nd November.

Western Isles Poverty Action Group – Campaign to reduce energy tariff with SSE. Further discussions taking place this week.

Housing Strategy – Maximum to be built about 33 per annum. Need to insulate as many houses as possible – expensive – costs about £17,000 per house.

Further Cuts – Shutting the council building in the evening so meeting rooms and the council Chamber will not be available. Rooms in the Nicolson Institute will be offered.

£830,000 overspend in the care system this year.
