Gaelic Level 1* - 6 week course - £22.50/£15 concession

A beginner-level class with an emphasis on spoken Gaelic. Topics will include greetings and introductions, days of the week, simple commands and general conversation, all in a friendly and relaxed environment.

A class for those who already have some Gaelic and would like to practice speaking and expand their vocabulary. Topics will include ordering in a restaurant, asking for directions and everyday conversations.

Basic Computing Level 2 - 6 week course - £30/£15 concession
