1. When contacted by members of the public do not use their names in public letters/minutes/anything public.
2. Stats regarding Loganair discussed last CC meeting were incorrect.
3. All minutes from CC meetings have to be submitted to CNES
4. Not all money donated by the CC has been confirmed by the recipients. Around £800 still to be cashed.
5. Still no answers to the medical questions. Alasdair Allan has confirmed he has received them and has written a letter to Gordon Jamieson requesting that the questions be answered.
6. Construct a list of people who we think ought to be contacted so that we can get answers to questions around the hub.
7. Invite the individuals in charge of funding the hub to make sure that public interests and safety are being met.
8. Euan Scott to explain the herring walk. Walked us through the notes he supplied us (See attached)

A. Approach has been made to the Scottish Government under the SG capital programme in regards to potential funding.

B. Until money is secured for its extension options for maintenance and repairs are being looked at.

C. Offer £300 from CC and possibly £300 more from CBAB if maintenance is approved. With this money offer it to the member of the community who is willing to help repair the walk.

D. Ask if the CNES could take the lease themselves and make it a public walkway.

E. See if it is possible to arrange a meeting between Iain MacNeil, Euan Scott and the High officer.
