## **Matters Arising**

# **Development Worker**

### Polycrub/Asset Transfer

Communn Eachdraigh have received a draft lease agreement for the asset transfer from Cala Mackenzie.

### Signage at Gress Beach

We are waiting for costings from Gordon Diesels for a 'leave nothing but footprints' sign. It was suggested to purchase a plastic sign so that it can't be burnt opposed to a wooden sign.

There has been no update on this. This will be kept on the agenda.

# **Speed Sign**

This is an ongoing issue. This would work more efficiently to be hard wired and fed from the lamppost. This would be in the best interest of the Comhairle to do this and it would save BCC chasing them every week to change the batteries. MA will phone Tubes about this.

#### **Crown Estate**

There is no confirmation on when the next round of funding will be – perhaps the start of 2022.

### **Brevig Harbour Users Group**

The harbour users group have been awarded money to clear the harbour but they are having a problem moving the wrecks. There has been no volunteer's clean-up day yet confirmed. This will be advertised in the Loch a Tuath News. Alex John and Gordon will be invited to the next meeting.

### **Finances**

The balance stands at £59, 377.46. This includes all the crown estate funding and play park monies.

#### **Caravan Park**
