MATTERS ARISING FROM MINUTE

Road Issues

Speed check with unmarked cars patrolling recently. Peter raised speed issue through Laxay. Angus to look further into this.

Heb drone survey re pavements is going ahead through Balallan and Laxay. This is being funded by CNES. Ken Roddy told the meeting that there is a problem with the streetlights in Balallan

Hebridean Way signage in Kintarvie needs replacing – Suzanne to action.

Flytipping

Angus has sourced signage for the quarry between Balallan and Airidhbhruaich. Discussion also re the possibility of this quarry being in use over the next while as bore tests were carried out there for the Eishken Windfarm. The community should keep reporting incidences of fly tipping where possible.

Kinloch Historical Society signage planning application has been submitted. Planning is now through and works in progress.
